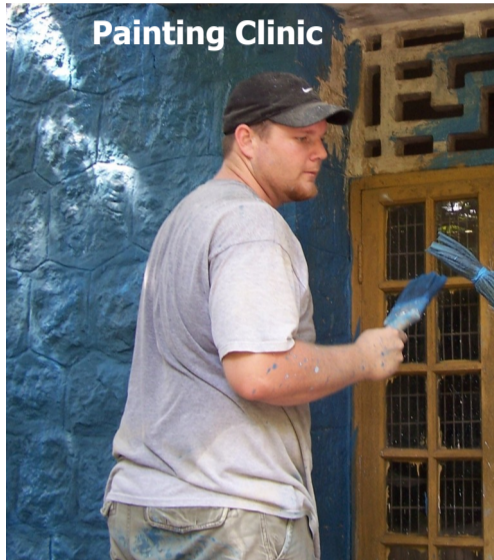
canoeing, boating, visiting Disney world, horse riding, and even getting to go to a Cowboy's football game. This is definitely one trip the boys

We head back to Cameroon on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of November. One thing our trip to the States has shown us is that Africa really feels like home now, we have missed it so much. The Lord has put such

a love for the people and the country in our hearts and we can't wait to get back. Two of our goals while on deputation was to increase our monthly support and raise all the set up costs for the orphanage which includes the first two years of rent (about \$17,000, you can look on our website for a breakdown of the costs). So far we have raised almost a third of this amount. We ask that you would seek the Lord on how to give to this much needed Children's Home in Cameroon. We've visited many orphanages in Cameroon and have yet to find one that is providing for the children's spiritual and physical needs at the same time. WON intends to create a clean, safe, loving, and spiritually
